Principals Report:

• Cell Phone Policy:

 Mr. MacDonald and Mr. Haverstock introduced the new cell phone policy as outlined below:

While we recognize the value of cell phones, we are also very much aware of the downfalls, such as, distraction from learning, taking unsolicited photos/video, playing games, and sending messages to students in other classes. Beginning on January 15th, the following cell phone policy will be put in place at EGMJH:

- All students will be asked to leave their cell phones in their lockers; they will not be permitted to have them in class. If a student does not feel that their locker is a safe place, we have the ability to securely store their phone in the main office.
- If a student is found using their phone in class, they will be asked to bring it to the office and it will be returned to them at the end of the school day. We will follow up with an email home.
- A second infraction will result in the student turning their cell phone into the office first thing in the morning for the remainder of the week. The phone will be returned at the end of every day.
- A third incident will result in a one day in-school suspension.
- If you need to reach your child, please contact the main office and we will make sure the message is passed on.
- The SAC members were in support of the policy. They asked if students were permitted to use music to help them concentrate and Mr. MacDonald said that we would supply wired earbuds for every student. He also explained that we

were ordering lock boxes for students' phones to go in when they are brought to the office.
